John Sauerhage - Clinic Co-Director

John Sauerhage is in his 17th season as Head Coach at UTA. During that time he has received 17 Southland Conference Coach of the Year awards and has coached 25 athletes to NCAA All-American honors. Specializing in distance and middle-distance running, Sauerhage has led his teams to 22 Southland Conference Team Titles, including the 2007 Men's Outdoor Track Championship. Coach Sauerhage was also named the 2007 NCAA South Central Region Coach of the Year.



John McKenzie - Co-Clinic Director

Director since 1973. Now a financial advisor for Merrill Lynch, the former track coach brings a wealth of experience to our clinic.



Tom Tellez - Former Head Coach at University of Houston

One of the greatest track coaches of all time. Coach Tellez has knowledge and expertise in every phase of track and field. He has guided Carl Lewis to an Olympic Gold Medal. Tom is truly a great teacher of our sport.



Jeremy Fischer - USA Track & Field Olympic Training Center

In five seasons as an assistant coach at Oklahoma, Fischer is in charge of jumps and multi-events with the Sooners. In 2009, Fischer led three Sooners to championships in jumps events. His top pupil, Will Claye, captured an NCAA Championship in triple jump while also breaking the school record. Fischer now works with the USA Track & Field Olympic Training Center.



Mike Maynard - Men's Head Coach at UCLA

One of the nation's elite coaches, Mike Maynard enters his third season as the men's head coach at UCLA. Mike spent the previous nine years as the head coach/throws coach at Boise State where he guided Gabe Wallin to back-to-back national championships in men's javelin and helped 30 athletes reach All-American status. Under Maynard's guidance, BSU won the WAC and finished 25th nationally in 2009.



Shawn Flanagan - Head Coach at Texas A&M-Corpus Christi

A 30-year veteran in coaching, Flanagan has led more than 50 runners to national championship meets in cross country and track & field. During his 11 seasons with the Islanders, Flanagan has led his teams to three Southland Conference cross country championships. Flanagan led Shadrack Songok to three NCAA national championships.



Ken Harnden - Assistant Coach at Florida State

A highly decorated coach, Ken Harnden can look back at the 2008 Olympics at the high point of his career. That is because Harnden coached six athletes competing in the 2008 Games, including two in the final heat for the 200m — Walter Dix and Brian Dzingai. Last year Harnden led Ngoni Makusha, Maurice Mitchell and the sprint relay teams to NCAA National Championships in the 100m, 200m and 4x100m Relay, respectively.



Brandon Berger - Assistant Coach at UT Arlington

Brandon Berger enters his sixth season as an assistant coach for the Mavs in 2011-2012. A budding star in the coaching world, Berger has helped produce conference champions in several events, including Romain Martin last year in the heptathlon and Isiah Clements in the high jump. Under Berger's tutelage, Martin finished second at the NCAA Indoor Championships in the heptathlon. Martin and Clements were both Second-Team All-America in 2011.



Jordan Durham - Assistant Coach at UT Arlington

Jordan Durham enters her third season as the program's sprint's coach. The rising star coach assisted in the development of All-American sprinters Cordero Gray and Jasmine Walls in 2009-10. In 2011, Durham mentored Gray and freshman Clayton Vaughn to Second-Team All-America standing. She was a three-time All-American at Arizona State where she was a member of the Sun Devils 2008 indoor national championship team.
